- Shuttles:** Feather only. One (1) shuttle per match will be supplied by the VBC. Additional shuttle needs are covered by the players.
- Scoring:** Best two out of three matches to 15 points. Setting to 3 points at 14:14 by the party that first reached 14 points. Ceiling/Basketball basket contact of the shuttle is a fault.
- Tournament format:** Open Singles and Doubles (no gender separation). Double-elimination, i.e., a lost game results in entry into the knock-out consolation round. Top players get first round byes.
- Showers, etc.:** Women's and men's changing rooms are available. Towels can be rented from the Recreation Center for 50 cents. Soap is available in dispensers in the showers.
- Lockers:** Bring a lock. There are plenty of free lockers available in the changing rooms to lock up your valuables.
- Food/Drinks:** Multiple cooled-water fountains are available. The VBC will supply bananas.
- Fees:** Upon arrival at the venue, please contribute \$5 per player so we can cover our expenses.
- Directions:** Please use Mapquest (<http://www.mapquest.com/directions/>) with "2800 Vanderbilt Place, Nashville, TN" as the going-to address. Also see map on page 2.
- Parking:** Important: Please park only on "Vanderbilt Pl." (see map on page 2) to avoid parking tickets. They are really quick with ticketing around here.

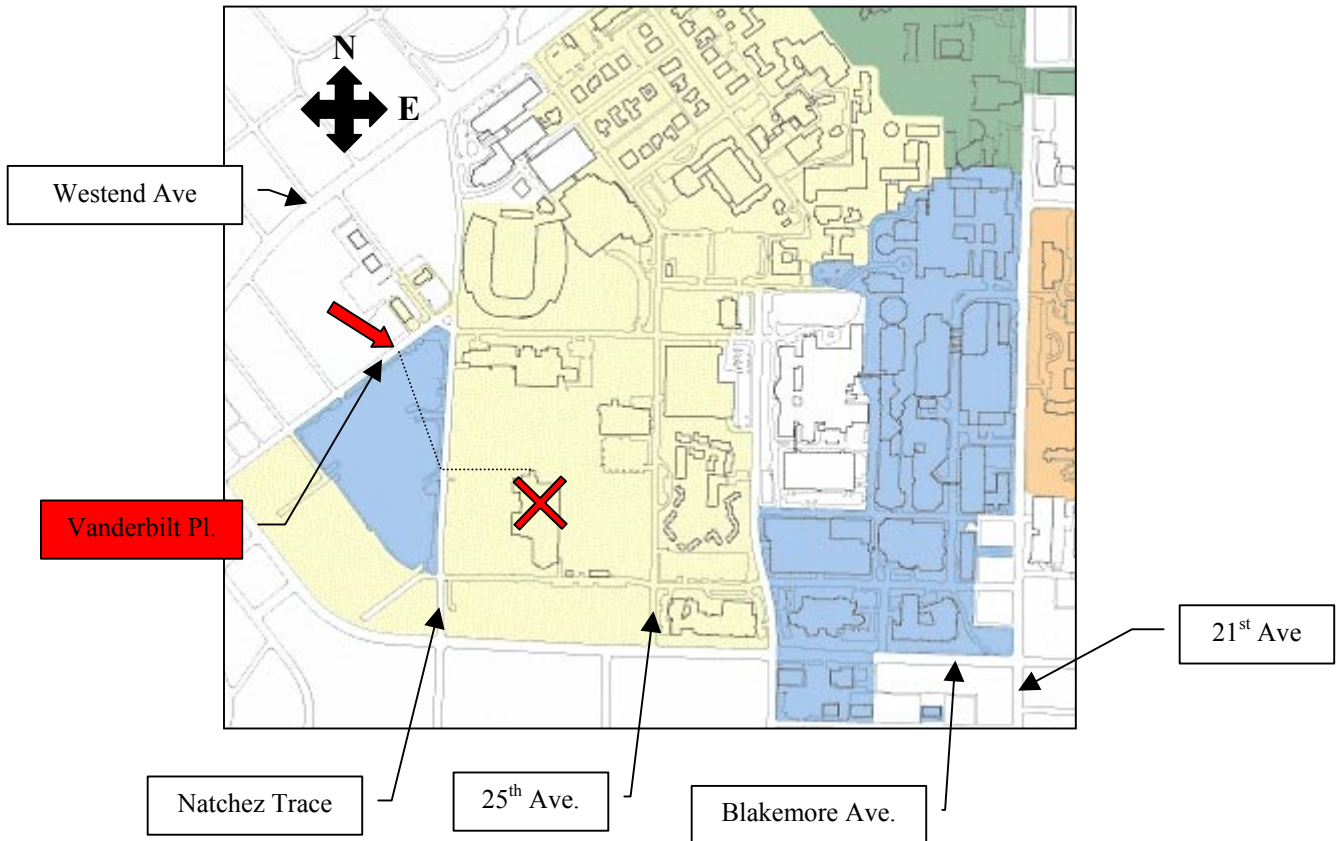
**THE VANDERBILT UNIVERSITY RECREATION CENTER:**

**PARKING:**
